With care in its installation and maintenance, you can expect it to have a long and economical service life. Before you go any further, please take a few minutes to look over this information, then save it for future reference and for the useful service information it contains.



Installation & Operation Procedures

INSTALLATION:

1. Depressurize and lockout air pressure.
2. Upstream pipes must be free of excessive dirt and liquids.
3. Install the Filter in airline as near as possible to the device it is to serve.
4. Install the Filter so air flows in same direction as arrow on head.
5. Filter should be installed before any Regulator, Lubricators or Valves in airline.

OPERATION:

1. Manual drains must be periodically drained of accumulated liquids.
For Plastic Bowls with Manual or Automatic Internal Drain, manually drain by pushing up on Drain Knob (#6).
For Metal Bowls with Manual or Automatic Internal Drain, manually drain by turning Drain Knob (#6) counter-clockwise.

TO CLEAN OR REPAIR:

1. Depressurize and lockout air pressure.
2. Remove Bowl Assembly (#3 or #7 or #8 or N.S.) by turning counter-clockwise.
3. Remove Filter Element (#2) by turning Stem (#4) counter-clockwise.
4. Do not clean white polyethylene elements, they must be replaced
5. Sintered Bronze elements may be cleaned by soaking several hours in a suitable solvent, then blowing them out with compressed air, in reverse direction to normal air flow.
6. To service automatic internal drain: Remove Bowl Assembly (#3 or #8) by turning counter-clockwise, then remove Piston Drain top (#5).
7. Clean Bowl Assembly (#3 or #8) and Piston Drain top (#5) with soap and water, then reassemble.
8. If the Filter cannot be repaired by cleaning with soap and water, the parts should be replaced.
9. Plastic bowls may be cleaned with soap and water. Replace plastic bowls with metal if any signs of crazing or cracking are observed.

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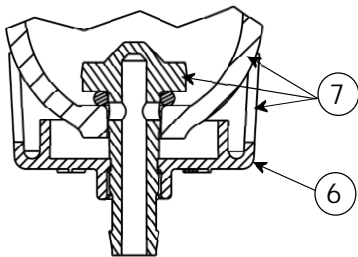
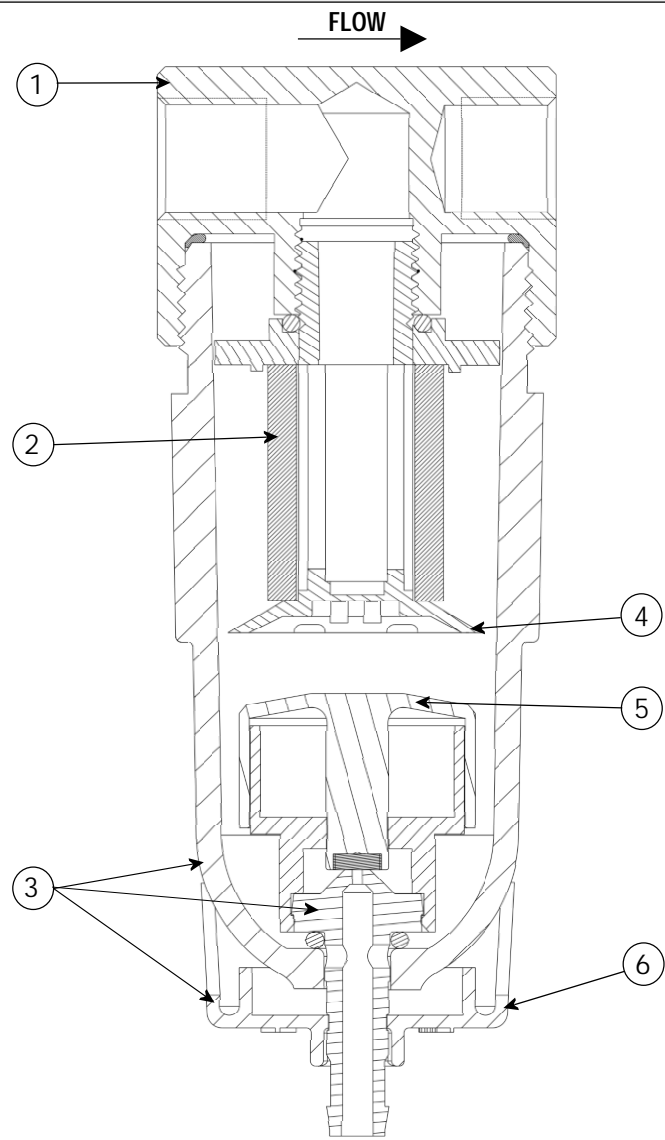
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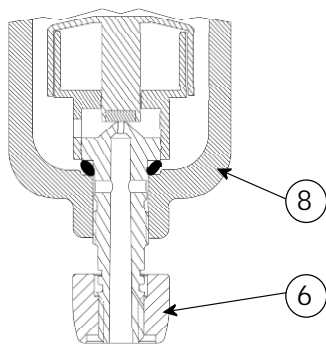
