# **OPW 7H and 7HB Automatic Nozzle Spout Replacement**

#### A. GENERAL

The 5-BH Spout Assembly is the replacement for the OPW 7H.

The 5-BBH Spout Assembly is the replacement for the OPW 7HB.


### **B. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Remove the hand insulator. Be sure to save the hand insulator for reuse later.
- 2. Remove the spout retaining screws from the nozzle near spout end and pull the old spout assembly out of the nozzle. Also remove the old seal rings. Throw the old parts away. Be sure there is no dirt or foreign matter in the outlet end of the nozzle.
- 3. Remove the large O-ring from the instruction sheet and coat it with a heavy lubricating oil.
- 4. Position the large O-ring on the shoulder of the spout adapter. This O-ring will seal the adapter to the nozzle body when the spout retaining screws are tightened.
- 5. Remove the small O-ring from the instruction sheet and coat it with a heavy lubricating oil.
- 6. Place the small O-ring on the machined brass shoulder of the spout adapter.
- 7. Insert the new spout assembly gently, but firmly, into the outlet end of the nozzle with a slight twisting motion until it will go no farther. Rotate the spout until the retaining screw holes in the adapter are in line with the screw holes in the nozzle.
- 8. Insert the spout retaining screws and tighten firmly. Replace the hand insulator.
- 9. Test the nozzle for shut-off in all clip positions by immersing the spout at least 2" in fuel. Spout tip should not rest against bottom of test can. If the nozzle fails to shut-off, remove it from service.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE O-RINGS ARE LUBRICATED AND THAT THE SPOUT IS INSERTED WITH A GENTLE BUT FIRM SLIGHT TWISTING MOTION. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY DAMAGE THE O-RINGS AND RESULT IN NOZZLE FAILURE.


